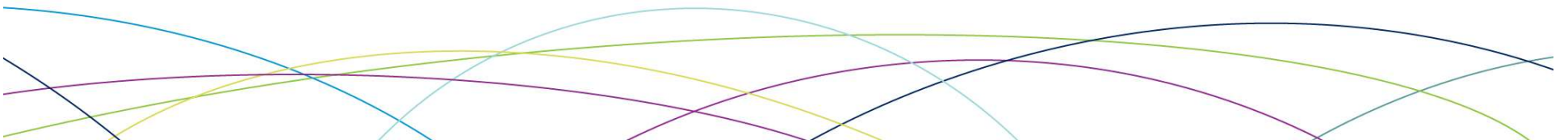

Innovation Proof-of-Concept Grant

This grant aims to strengthen Manitoba-based research innovation and development products by filling a funding gap in the innovation ecosystem.

Award Amounts and Duration

Stream 1: Manitoba-Based Consortium - \$150,000 over 2 years

- Supports local collaboration that is addressing a company specific discovery towards market usability.

Stream 2: Manitoba Post-Secondary Researchers - \$100,000 over 2 years

- Supports the advancement of discoveries or innovations within an academic setting, which may result in products or technologies, towards market usability.

Expression of Interest Deadlines

- June, September, December, March 15th annually
